3	DOH Contract	Dave Bowen, Chairman	Ms. Erlich introduced herself as the Department's counsel regarding PDMP and introduced Michael Grief as the transactional contract attorney. Ms. Erlich advised the board that execution of the contract is necessary to move forward. The board discussed their concerns.

4	Treasurer's Report Receipts Disbursements Review spending plan and budget codes	Rod Steele, Treasurer	The treasurer was not present at the meeting. The most recent balance sheet was provided in the meeting materials for the board's review.	
5	Fund Raising • Asset Forfeiture Donations • Sunshine Law	Dave Bowen, Chairman Sheriff Lamberti	Chairman Bowen advised that there were some fundraising barriers during the 2011 legislative session when the future of the PDMP was unknown. People were concerned about whether the program would move forward. Interested has resurfaced now that the program is being implemented. Chairman Bowen advised that he is still waiting on a response to the question regarding whether legislators can donate campaign contribution surpluses. Sheriff Lamberti advised that he has spoken with the Sheriffs across the state and they are very interested in donating asset forfeiture money to the PDMP Foundation. So far, 28 counties have committed to donating asset forfeiture funds. Other counties have requested a follow-up request. Sheriff Lamberti advised that he will be attending a Florida Sheriff Association Meeting at 1:00 p.m. this afternoon and that he will be on the agenda to implement the donations. Sheriff Lamberti indicated that the Sheriffs need to know what the fundraising target is. Sheriff Lamberti advised that donations from asset forfeiture funds could be made annually.

			Ms. Poston advised the board that a minimum of \$475,000 is needed annually to operate the PDMP. Should the Department receive federal or private grants or donations, the amount needed from the Foundation would be less.
			Ms. Pat Gleason from the Office of the Attorney General appeared before the Board of Directors to provide guidance on Sunshine Law issues. Ms. Gleason advised that there can be no communications between board members, outside of publicly noticed meetings.
6	PDMP Update • Implementation • Participants • Education Strategies • Performance Measures	Becki Poston & Erika Marshall	Ms. Poston informed the board that PDMP staff has been busy with the implementation of mandatory reporting on September 1, and providing educational opportunities. Ms. Poston advised that staff has been in front of over 5,000 practitioners so far. Educational efforts include presentations and exhibitions at state regulatory board meetings, professional association meetings, written materials, and an online webinar.
